Treasurer Report / Yearly Summary (W. Bush)

- Beginning year balance \$20,388.09
- Expenses to date \$10,836.70 (\$6288.30 lower than projected budget)

Old Business

Sidewalk repair (L. Schauff)

- Discussion on bids tabled until spring.
- Larry has followed- up since meeting to provide a budget estimate for 2016:



To remove and repair one section of sidewalk costs ~350-\$400. A truckload of concrete covers ~25 squares of sidewalk. From the last survey completed in 2014, 26 of the 92 lots had sidewalk cracks; of the 26 lots (~ 44 squares) have cracks of some degree. Many (12 of 19) handicap ramps are cracked. Most cracks are minimal; however lots 12, 28, 32, 39, 54, 70, 77 have either multiple cracks and/or are tripping hazards this would account for 21 sections. Recommend that the board budget a truckload of concrete, this would take care of about 25 squares of side walk, ramps would require more concrete and increased labor. One section of side walk labor and material \$350-\$400/section X 25 sections = \$8750-\$10000.

- Reminder to homeowners: Please let a board member know of sidewalk problems so it can be added to the inventory for repairs.
- Lot 32 reports a hole in sidewalk.

Weed grants

- Larry reported that the State has recently funded the weed grant program so we will hopefully receive grant applied for.
